How to use .bst files?

1. Your references should be in a .bib file, say 'SomeEnReferences.bib'
2. The above file and your .bst file should be in the system path or the current directory.
3. For seeing the file structure, see the source files of this example.
4. In TeXMaker, press F1, F11, F1 and F1.

Example: In Amintoosi et al. (2009) a new method has been introduced.
